


Memorandum
between the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance
of the Russian Federation and Governmental Agency for Food and Veterinary
Control of the Faroe Islands on conditions of delivery of products
subject to state veterinary control from the Faroe Islands to the Russian Federation

For the purpose of effective control over deliveries from the Faroe Islands to the Russian Federation of products (meat and raw meat products, fish, fishery and seafood products – hereinafter referred to as meat and fishery products) which are subject to state veterinary control the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance (Rosselkhoznadzor) and Governmental Agency for Food and Veterinary Control of the Faroe Islands (Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands) have agreed as follows:


1. Meat and fishery products deliveries from the Faroe Islands to the Russian Federation will be made from the moment of signing this Memorandum only from establishments (vessels) approved by Rosselkhoznadzor for exporting their products to the Russian Federation, without intermediate storing and splitting of the consignments after their final certification.
2. Establishments (vessels) approved by Rosselkhoznadzor for exporting their products to the Russian Federation on submission from Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands will be further inspected by Rosselkhoznadzor representatives. Decisions on next deliveries from these establishments (vessels) will be made according to the results of the inspections.
3. Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands guarantees that meat and fishery products exported from establishments (vessels) of the Faroe Islands to the Russian Federation are safe and have high quality. Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands will take all appropriate measures to prevent possible delivery to the territory of the Russian Federation of potentially hazardous in veterinary-sanitary respect meat and fishery products.
4. By 25 January, 2009 Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands will have communicated to Rosselkhoznadzor in writing any changes in the lists of establishments (vessels) approved by Rosselkhoznadzor. Approval of the establishments (vessels) takes effect not later than 30 days after presenting the updated list unless Rosselkhoznadzor raises objections during this time period. The approved list comes into force within two weeks to allow Rosselkhoznadzor to advise its veterinary border control posts.
5. Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands carries responsibility for regular supervision over the approved establishments (vessels) in order to guarantee that appropriate veterinary and sanitary requirements are fulfilled on a regular basis. If during such supervision an approved establishment (vessel) is found to have failed to satisfy the requirements, Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands shall suspend the products deliveries from the establishment and inform Rosselkhoznadzor about the fact.
6. Rosselkhoznadzor will carry out inspection visits to the Faroe Islands in order to verify the guarantees provided for in paragraphs 1, 3, and 5 of the Memorandum. These audits will include on-site inspection of a certain representative number of establishments (vessels) determined by Rosselkhoznadzor on the basis of risk analysis from the list provided by Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands. Rosselkhoznadzor shall submit the audit report to Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands and consider possible comments of the latter. Based on the audit results the existing list of the establishments may be amended.



7. If an establishment (vessel) has been de-listed because of its non-compliance with Russian veterinary and sanitary requirements, Rosselkhoznadzor will reconsider approval of this establishment (vessel) in accordance with paragraph 5 on the basis of guarantees provided by Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands to the effect that shortcomings have been rectified and the establishment (vessel) again complies with Russian veterinary and sanitary requirements or, depending on the level and nature of risk, after an inspection by Rosselkhoznadzor within the shortest time period possible.
8. Deliveries of meat and fishery products from the Faroe Islands to the Russian Federation will be carried out with obligatory pre-notification of Rosselkhoznadzor in accordance with Appendix 1 under modalities to be agreed between Rosselkhoznadzor and Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands.

9. Issues of further attestation of the Faroe Islands establishments (vessels) interested in delivering their products to the Russian Federation will be regulated according to the requests from Veterinary Agency of the Faroe Islands and Russian importers.
10. Parties have come to mutual understanding on the need to continue constructive dialogue on the issue of delivering from the Faroe Islands to the Russian Federation of consignments subject to state veterinary control.


