- the above mentioned farm equipment has been thoroughly cleaned of organic materials and soil with the help of a high pressure cleaner.
- the equipment has then been disinfected<sup>2</sup> with e.g. an oxidizing disinfecting agent (Virkon®S, working solution: 2% corresponding to 200g of Virkon®S powder per 10 litres of water, with a process time of at least 30 minutes at 18°C<sup>3</sup>) both on the exterior and interior.

<sup>1</sup> In this connection farm equipment is understood as: tractors, farming machinery and implements, horse trailers, riding equipment etc.

<sup>2</sup> Disinfection is carried out by covering the farm equipment with a clear plastic cover and evenly spraying it under the cover with a disinfecting agent with for example the aid of a back spray in order that the surfaces are kept damp during the processing time.

<sup>3</sup> The processing time must be doubled or halved when the temperature is 10°C lower or higher respectively
