- II.1. consists of fish oil that satisfy the health requirements below;
- II.2. contains exclusively fish oil not intended for human consumption;
- II.3. has been prepared and stored in a dedicated fish plant approved, validated and supervised by the competent authority in accordance with Article 17 and where appropriate Article 11 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002;
- II.4. has been prepared exclusively with the following animal by-products:

⁽²⁾ either [- former foodstuffs of fish origin, other than catering waste⁽³⁾, which are no longer intended for human consumption for commercial reasons or due to problems of packaging defects or other defects which do not present any risk to humans or animals,]

⁽²⁾ and/or [- fish or other sea animals, except sea mammals, caught in the open sea for the purposes of fishmeal production,]

⁽²⁾ and/or [- fresh by-products from fish from plants manufacturing fish products for human consumption;]

- II.5. the fish oil;
 - (a) has been subjected to processing in accordance with Annex VII, Chapter IV of Regulation 1774/2002/EC, in order to kill pathogenic agents;
 - (b) has not been in contact with other types of oils including rendered fats from other animal species; and

⁽²⁾ either [(c) is packaged in new containers that have been cleaned and all precautions taken to prevent their contamination;]

⁽²⁾ or [- (c) where bulk transport is intended, the pipe, pumps and bulk tanks and any other bulk container or bulk road tanker used in the transportation of the product from the manufacturing plant either directly on to the ship or into shore tanks or direct to plants have been inspected and found to be clean before use;]

Part I:

- Box reference 1.6: Person responsible for the consignment in EU: this box is to be filled in only if it is a certificate for transit commodity; it may be filled in if the certificate is for import commodity.
- Box reference 1.12: Place of destination: this box is to be filled in only if it is a certificate for transit commodity. The products in transit can only be stored in free zones, free warehouses and custom warehouses.
- Box reference 1.15: Registration number (railway wagons or container and lorries), flight number (aircraft) or name (ship); information is to be provided in the event of unloading and reloading.
- Box reference 1.19: use the appropriate HS code 15.04 or 15.18
- Box reference 1.23: for bulk containers, the container number and seal number (if applicable) should be included.
- Box reference 1.26 and 1.27: fill in according to whether it is a transit or an import certificate.
- Box reference 1.28: Manufacturing plant: provide the registration number of the treatment/processing establishment.
